**SUMMER IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE PROJECTS** This summer the Cathedral is undertaking some important building maintenance and improvement projects you may see as you walk around the property. We will be repairing plaster and paint on the east and west walls, so scaffolding may be visible in the Nave during services for several weeks. Additionally, we will also soon be starting a roof repair and improvement project that will take a couple of months and include copper flashing and masonry on the front peak of the building on Broadway.
